How to make an Urban LAB “Through the eyes of a woman”:

To Bring:
Camera, note book,
sketch pad, pen etc.

1. Pick a public space in your city

2. Go to that space and observe, interview or gather improvement ideas on the public space from the woman's perspective.

3. Describe the woman's perspective of the space through visual drawings, sketches, photos, or narratives.

4. Gather the material and send it together with a description of the space to dadasconnect@hoperaisers.net

Think about and answer the following questions:

- What kind of space is it (park, square, street, street corner etc)?
- What activities takes place?
- What women do you see and what do they do?
- Is the place supporting the activities they do, if not what could be improved?
- Imagine you, as a woman, would use this place at different times during the day, what would you do and what would you not do? How would you feel? Where in the space would you feel comfortable?
- Do you see any physical features within the space that you think is good/bad?

The session ends with a summarize and discussion session. The compiled material will be part of an exhibition and a book that represents and discuss the City from the woman's perspective. E-mail the material to dadasconnect@hoperaisers.net
